(1). The tuition fees (as approved by the Board of Trustees of the Savior International Schools) are displayed in the table below:

(2). Students who are applying for a discount can benefit from the appropriate discount if they meet the conditions listed in the table below. For this purpose, it is necessary to submit the necessary documents for each discount to the head of admissions and if approved, the discount code will be given to you to apply on the site.

Discount Package Name	Amount of Discount	Required Documents
Financial inability (A)	Up to 45%	Completion of the certificate of financial inability by the local Imam and a colleague or friend of the parents, and its approval by the financial and administrative department of the complex (the form of the certificate can be obtained from the admission section)
Memorizers of the whole Quran (B)	15%	Valid certificate from the Endowment Directorate, The Islamic Culture and Guidance Department, The Quran Society etc, or receive approval from the school's cultural department.
Martyrs' Children (C)	25%	Certificate from the Martyr's Foundation, Fatemiyoun and Zainebiyoun Brigades.
Children of disabled war veterans (D)	15%	Certificate from the Martyr's Foundation, Fatemiyoun and Zainebiyoun Brigades.
Children of teachers and staff of the complex (E)	20%	Approval by the Financial and Administrative Department.
Talented individuals with an average score of 90 or higher (I)	10%	Approval from the Education Department.

Note 1: The religious and legal responsibility for using the discount package (A) for students who are financially capable is the responsibility of the parents and if it is proven that person is financially capable, the discount will be cancelled.

Note 2: The maximum applicable discount for people who are illegible to choose several discount packages will be 50%.

3). The student insurance fee for one academic year is 30,000 Toman.

4). In case of non-payment of tuition fee installments on time, the school has no obligation to provide educational services to the students such as participation in exams, issuing report sheets, permission to attend classes etc,. Furthermore, the school can prevent the student from attending the school.

5). The tuition fee card is the legal proof for student tuition payment, and in case of financial disputes, the tuition fee card is the citation reference. Furthermore, any possible consequences in a situation whereby the tuition fee card is lost or damaged is the responsibility of the parents.

- 6). If the tuition fees will be paid in installments, the parents must pay a quarter of the total tuition fee amount upon registration in addition to student insurance as a deposit.
- 7). If the tuition fees will be paid in installments, the maximum number of installments should be five installments per month which begins from the month of Mehr (September/October) and parents must complete payment by the end of the month of Bahman (January/February). In case of missing the deadline in each month, a written reminder will be sent, and if three notices are given, all discounts will be cancelled.
- 8). Paying the tuition fees in cash means the student will pay the full tuition fee upon registration; otherwise, it will be regarded as payment in installments.
- 9). Parents have the opportunity to change the method of payment from cash to installments before the official beginning of the school academic year.
- 10). The tuition fees are calculated in installments immediately after the start of the academic year.
- 11). In case of withdrawal from the nursery level up to a week after the beginning of the school year, 75% of the tuition fee will be refunded, after which no amount will be refunded.
- 12). In case of withdrawal from the primary school or first and second year of middle school level up to two weeks after the beginning of the school year, 75% of the tuition fee will be refunded after which no amount will be refunded.
- 13). If paying in installments, if a student withdraws from the school, the remaining amount will be regarded as a debt which the parents are legally and religiously obliged to pay.
- 14). Student tuition fees do not include the cost of books, uniforms and services. Purchasing these items is the responsibility of the parents.
- 15). The tuition fees for all students who resided outside Iran during the last academic year will be paid in dollars or its equivalent rate in Rials on the day of payment. (The criteria for residency are visa and resume.)
- 16). Tuition fees for all students whose visas are processed by the school will be paid in dollars or its equivalent rate in Rials on the day of payment.

17). Families who enroll more than one student in Savior International Schools, in addition to other discounts that can be applied for each of the children, discounts for the last child are calculated as follows:

- (A). Family which has two students: 30% discount for the second child.
- (B). Family which has three students: 35% discount for the third child.
- (C). Family which has four students: 40% discount for the fourth child.
- (D). Family which has five students: 45% discount for the fifth child.

18). In case of any damage to the school and its property by the student, parents of the said student are obliged to compensate the damage and pay the appropriate fine.

19). Students who applied to participate in promotional tests must pay the equivalent of the said academic year's school fees if the request is approved..

20). Students who apply for early exams due to special circumstances must pay 200,000 Tomans for each subject before any exam after approval from the school board. Of course, report cards and results will be given according to the official school schedule.

21). In case a student wants to participate in the Khordad (June) exams for a second time, the student must pay 100,000 Tomans for each subject to attend the exams.
